16th Mumbai International Film Festival (MIFF-2020) inaugurated

Much awaited by cinephiles across India and the world, the 16th MIFF-2020 (Mumbai International Film Festival for Documentary, Short Fiction and Animation films), inaugurated on January 28, 2020 at Nehru Centre Auditorium, Worli, Mumbai. The festival will conclude with an award ceremony at the same venue on 3rd February at 5.00 p.m. The MIFF attracts filmmakers from all over the world. This edition has received 729 entries in National and 144 in International competition from 24 countries.

Apart from screening of wide variety of films in competition sections, departed legends of documentary and animation genre will be remembered with special screenings in homage apart from exhibitions on a few of them.

MIFF 2020 hosted a panel discussion on "Issues faced by Documentary filmmakers in getting permissions". Maharashtra Film Cell representatives were a part of the discussion and informed the attendees about

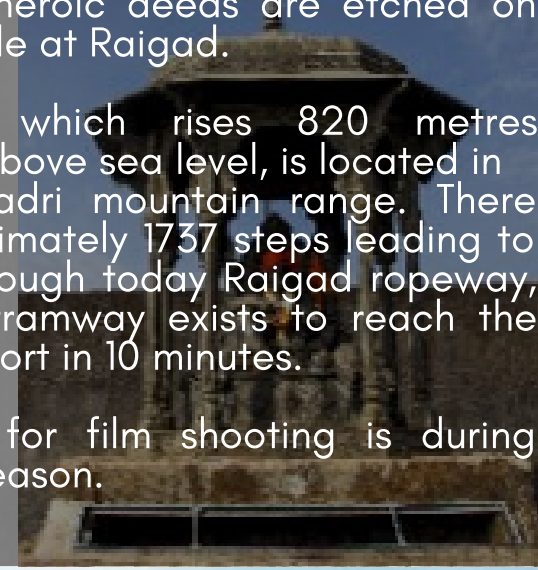

Raigad Fort was the capital of the most illustrious Maratha sovereign, nurtured by Chhatrapati Shivaji Maharaj. It is a monument of his prophetic vision of Hindavi Swarajya. Stories of incredible valor and heroic deeds are etched on every pebble at Raigad.

The fort, which rises 820 metres (2,700 ft) above sea level, is located in the Sahayadri mountain range. There are approximately 1737 steps leading to the fort, though today Raigad ropeway, an aerial tramway exists to reach the top of the fort in 10 minutes.

Best time for film shooting is during monsoon season.

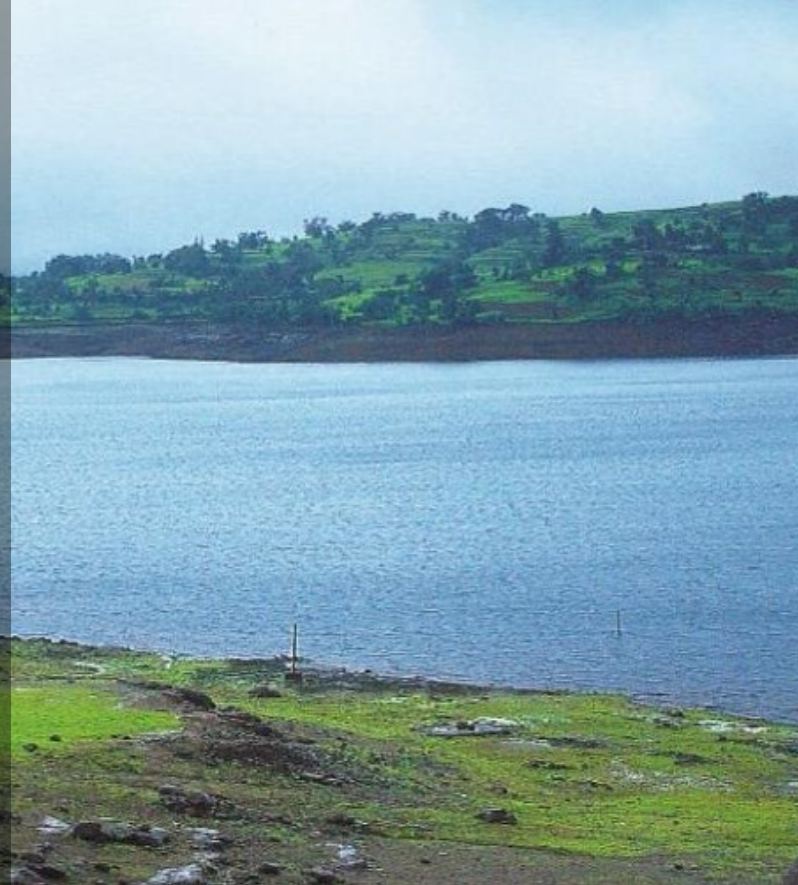


IGATPURI
