2. Please select User Type as "Production House" and entity as "National"

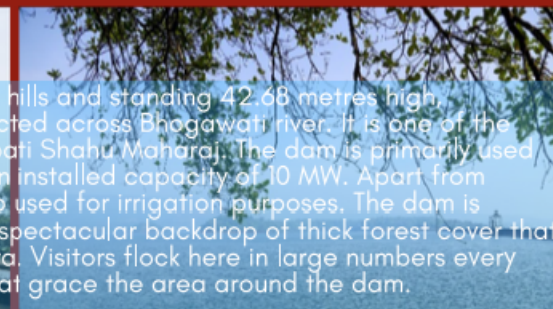
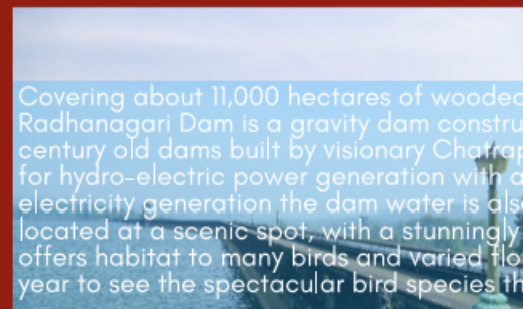
3. You would need following details and documents at the time of registration

## JULY SPOTLIGHT



Covering about 11,000 hectares of wooded hills and standing 42.68 metres high, Radhanagari Dam is a gravity dam constructed across Bhogawati river. It is one of the century old dams built by visionary Chatrapati Shahu Maharaj. The dam is primarily used for hydro-electric power generation with an installed capacity of 10 MW. Apart from electricity generation the dam water is also used for irrigation purposes. The dam is located at a scenic spot, with a stunningly spectacular backdrop of thick forest cover that offers habitat to many birds and varied flora. Visitors flock here in large numbers every year to see the spectacular bird species that grace the area around the dam.

A trip to Sindhudurg coastal region is incomplete without taking a ride in its famous backwaters - a hidden gem in the coastal region of Maharashtra. The backwaters are the most enjoyable experience as they offer a picturesque stretch of land endowed with beautiful seashore, scenic mountains and pleasing natural beauty. Mentioned below are a few popular places of nature tourism. Walaval Backwaters - The backwaters at Walaval offer a truly spell binding view of the Tarkarli creek (Estuary). It is situated between the majestic mountains that slope down to meet the stream. But in order to see this view, one has to trek from Mauli Temple to a huge rock situated on the top of the hill towards the west. It is during the summers that tourists turn out in large numbers at Walaval backwaters. Nerurpar - It is a 15km long channel at Kudal providing excellent view for cinematographers; Others include Karli, Katwan, Aronda - Kiranpani, etc. Houseboat stays are also available in the region.
