Getting film shooting permissions in Maharashtra was mired with several issues like issues like Non-standardized application format, long-time duration for approvals, multiple approvals through multiple channels, physical application and document submission just to name a few. § Acknowledging all these issues faced by the industry and to simplify the current offline process, Government Resolution No: गोचिन २०१६/प्र. क्र.१८९/ सां. का.१ stating establishment of Single Window Cell for film shooting permissions in Maharashtra as a part of Ease of Doing Business, was issued on May 22, 2018.

Maharashtra Film Stage and Cultural Development Corporation (MFSCDC) was appointed as the nodal agency for implementation of the GR. MFSCDC engaged services of M/s Ernst & Young LLP to undertake the for implementing Single Window System for film shooting permissions in Maharashtra.

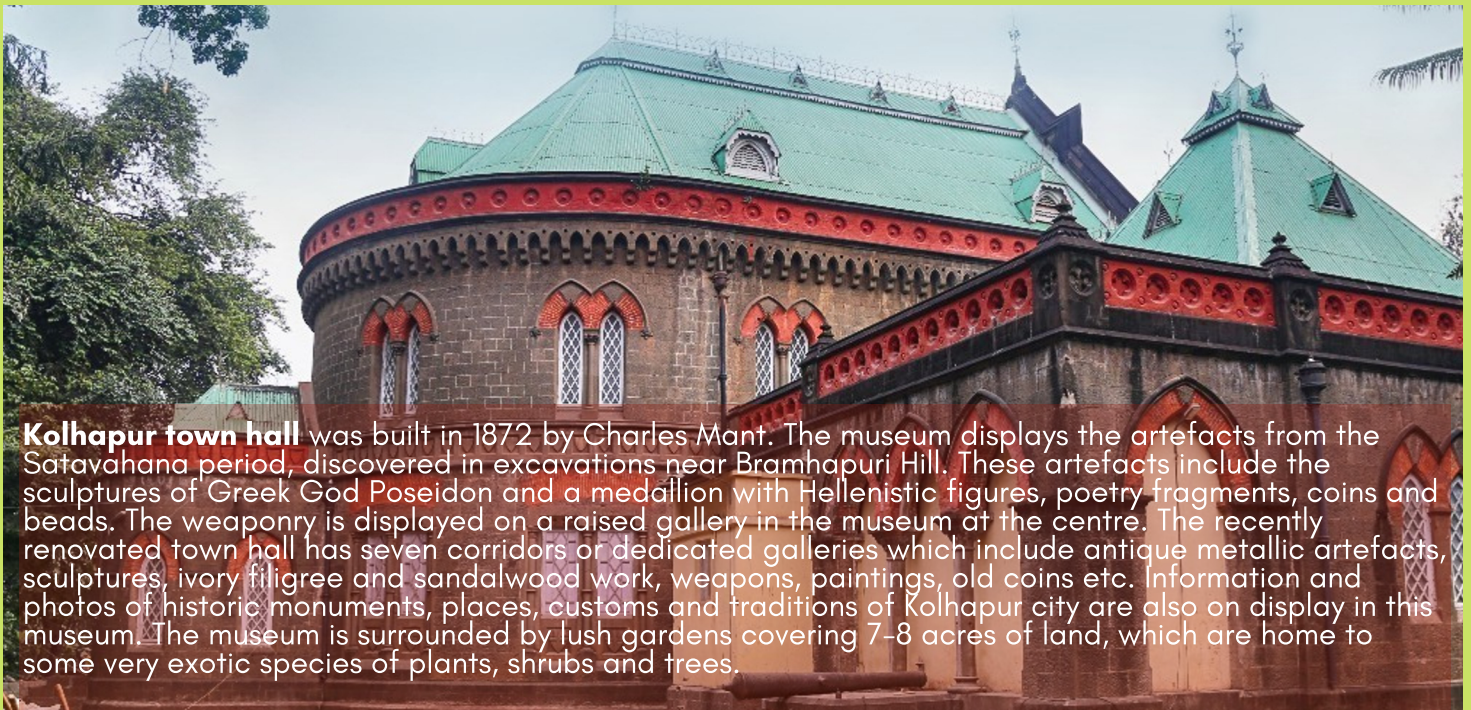
The portal, Maharashtra Film Cell will be live from August 14, 2019 and is accepting applications for film shooting permissions for state government owned premises/locations in Mumbai city and Mumbai suburban as a part first phase

We have 7 major state departments on board and have a database of more than 400 locations in the system.

Matheran is one of the most famous hill stations situated in Karjat Tehsil, Raigad District of Maharashtra, India. It is located on the range of Western Ghats at height of 800 m (2625 Feet) above sea level. Matheran has been declared as an eco-sensitive region by the government and automobiles are not allowed inside the town. This is what makes it a very peaceful location. There are about 28 points, 2 lakes, 2 parks & 4 major worship places in Matheran. It can be considered to be the best cinematographic location with respect to calm, scenic, backdrop.



Kolhapur town hall was built in 1872 by Charles Mant. The museum displays the artefacts from the Satavahana period, discovered in excavations near Bramhapuri Hill. These artefacts include the sculptures of Greek God Poseidon and a medallion with Hellenistic figures, poetry fragments, coins and beads. The weaponry is displayed on a raised gallery in the museum at the centre. The recently renovated town hall has seven corridors or dedicated galleries which include antique metallic artefacts, sculptures, ivory filigree and sandalwood work, weapons, paintings, old coins etc. Information and photos of historic monuments, places, customs and traditions of Kolhapur city are also on display in this museum. The museum is surrounded by lush gardens covering 7-8 acres of land, which are home to some very exotic species of plants, shrubs and trees.
