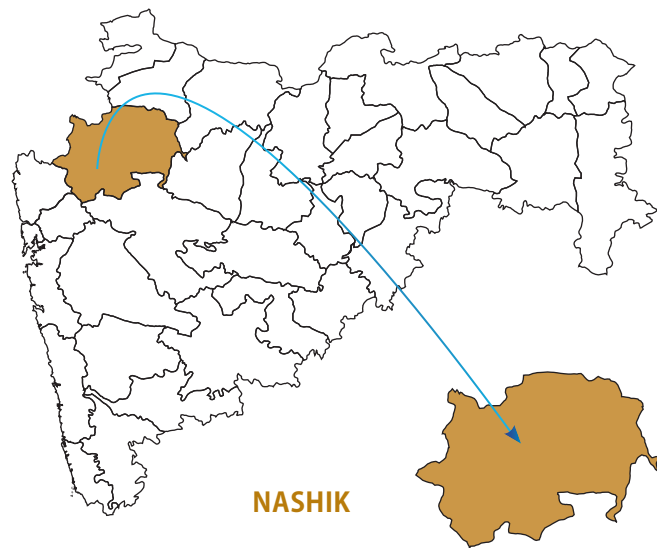




RANG MAHAL – HOLKARWADA

Built by Maharani Ahilya Bai Holkar in 18th century CE (Common Era), Rang Mahal is located in Chandwad region and surrounded by mountains. The magnificent grandeur of the palace is now being structurally restored by the State Archaeology Department. The premise houses a stepwell and two *chowks* in the north and south of the wada. The palace is known for its carved wooden pillars and ornamented facade.

The palace’s network of subways to popular locations such as Goddess Renuka Temple and a well near Vinchur built by Maharani Ahilya Bai to provide safe passage is famous. The Chandwad region is also known for the Chandraprabhu Caves which holds special importance for Jains.

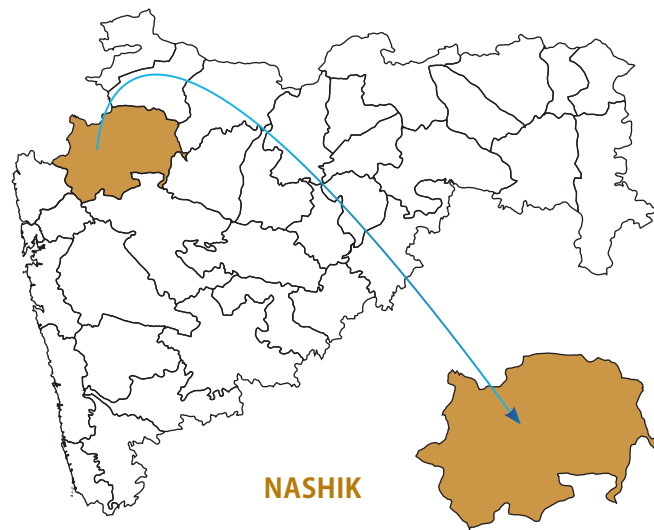


SARKARWADA – ADMINISTRATIVE HEADQUARTERS OF THE PESHWAS

Sarkarwada, which served as the administrative headquarters of the Peshwas, is located in the centre of Nashik city. It is an architectural delight with intricate wood carvings.

The two-storey premises which is being renovated by the State Archaeology Department, currently houses government offices. The main hall on the first floor has been renovated and preserves the royal *darbar* as it existed during Peshwa rule.

Sarkarwada is where Anant Kanhare and other freedom fighters were detained in the infamous Nashik Conspiracy Case of 1909.

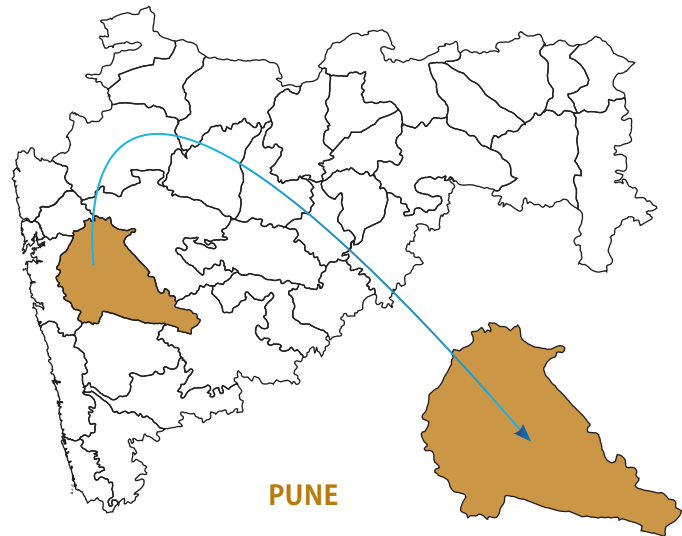




SHANIWAR WADA – THE MAGNIFICENT PESHWA MANSION

Shaniwar Wada became the palace of the Peshwas after the capital of the Maratha Empire shifted from Satara to Pune in 18th century CE (Common Era). It is known as Shaniwar Wada because the construction of the palace started on a Saturday. Situated in Shaniwar Peth in Pune, the palace is spread over 625 acres. Its heavily-fortified façade with nine bastions and five gateways exhibits a fair influence of Mughal architecture.

The north-facing main entrance of the monument is known as Delhi Darwaza because Peshwa Bajirao had ambitions of conquering Delhi.

- Shaniwar Wada is near Pune city in Pune district. Pune city has a population of ~31,00,000.
- Pune has an average high temperature of 38 degree Celsius and a low of 12 degree Celsius.
- The wada is connected by rail (Pune, 2.6 km), air (Pune, 11.1 km) and road (Mumbai, 150 km).
- Some of the nearest attractions are Vishrambaug Wada, Lal Mahal, Aga Khan Palace, etc.
- Pune is a major metropolitan city and has several star and budget category hotels and resorts.
- Ample catering facilities and restaurants offering multiple cuisines are available across the city.
- Pune has good medical facilities as well as speciality hospitals.

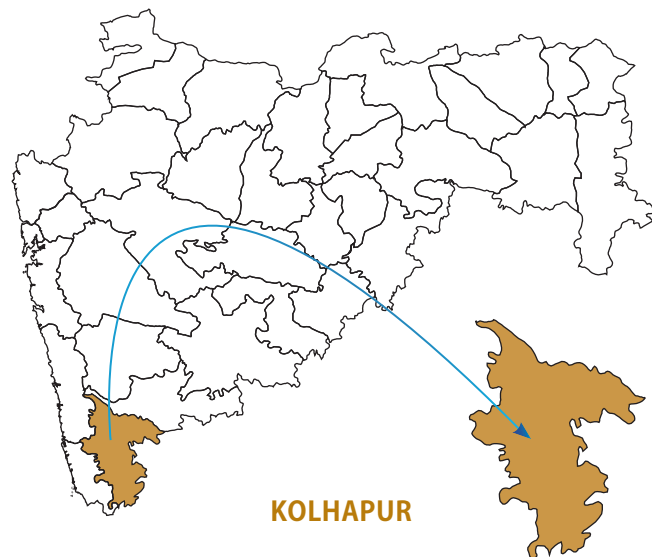


NEW LAXMI VILAS PALACE – A HISTORICAL MARVEL

The new Laxmi Vilas Palace, which also houses the Chhatrapati Shahu Museum, is a historic building designed by British architect Charles Mant. Built in black polished stone, it is an excellent specimen of a fusion of Jain and Hindu architectural styles.

The octagon-shaped building with a tower in the centre boasts of extensive premises comprising of gardens, fountains and a wrestling ground. A magnificent Darbar Hall in the middle of the palace is an excellent expression of the regal splendour of the Maratha Empire.

Today, the first floor of the palace serves as the residence of the current Maharaja of Kolhapur while the ground floor has been converted into the Chhatrapati Shahu Museum.
